

## Directions

### From Hewlett, Woodmere, Inwood:

Main Street to Atlantic Ave. Continue to Long Beach Road. Turn right, go to Waukena Ave. Turn left, go to Skillman Ave. Turn right to entrance of club.

### From North and Eastern Long Island:

Take Meadowbrook Pkwy S to Sunrise Hwy West (Exit 8W). Take Sunrise Hwy to Oceanside Road (Taco Bell & Hess Station). Make a left onto Oceanside Road. Follow directions below.\*\*

### From Manhattan:

Take Queens Midtown Tunnel to L.I. Expwy. Turn off sign Grand Central Pkwy to Van Wyck Expwy. Continue on Van Wyck to Belt Pkwy E. Continue on Belt Pkwy to Sunrise Hwy. Continue on Sunrise Hwy past Rockville Centre to Oceanside Road (Taco Bell & Hess). Turn right onto Oceanside Road. Follow directions below.\*\*

### From Verrazano Bridge:

Take Verrazano to Belt Pkwy E. Continue on Belt Pkwy to Sunrise Hwy past Rockville Centre to Oceanside Road. Turn right onto Oceanside Road. Follow directions below.\*\*

## Shrine History

The National Shrine of Our Lady of Mount Carmel was first established in 1941 in our Parish of Mount Carmel at 28<sup>th</sup> Street and First Avenue in Manhattan. The Shrine began when the people associated with it began making millions of scapulars for the Armed Forces in World War II. It grew as a place of worship, offering people the chance to participate in many novenas, study and reflection days, as well as the celebration of Masses. The Shrine promoted devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Carmelite Saints and the spirituality of Carmel.

In 1991, with the approval and encouragement of His Eminence, John Cardinal O'Connor, the National Shrine of Our Lady of Mount Carmel was transferred to Middletown because it was a more suitable spot for prayer and reflection. Today, thousands of pilgrims visit the Shrine each year. In addition to the Shrine Chapel, the National Shrine features shrines honoring Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, the Infant of Prague, Our Lady of Knock and Saint Patrick, among others.
